

A. Prayer of the Faithful

- 1. For a greater commitment among the Missionary Cenacle Family and the Church to seek freedom from injustice, oppression, and poverty for the immigrant community; *Let us Pray to the Lord*.
- 2. For the many lay collaborators and benefactors who generously support us and collaborate with us in mission; *Let us Pray to the Lord*.
- 3. For a renewed courage to continue challenging and changing systemic systems that hold back people based on racial and cultural biases; *Let us Pray to the Lord*.
- 4. For an increase of hope, faith, and charity in the Church and the world through the faithful living of our Charism, to preserve the faith, and through our commitment to being prophetic witness to the truth; *Let us Pray to the Lord*.
- 5. For a recommitment to the Family Spirit, that we move beyond ourselves to form a community composed of brothers and sisters who accept and care for one another; *Let us Pray to the Lord*.

We lift these prayers with gratitude for the Missionary Cenacle legacy entrusted to us as we recommit to the future. So we ask you, Holy and Undivided Trinity, to inflame our hearts with the same fire of your love you enkindled Fr. B. Prayer of the Faithful

- 4. For those who are oppressed by war and violence: so that, under the action of the Holy Spirit, it makes them feel like beloved children of the Father and brothers in the risen Christ, who gives us the peace that comes from God. *Let us Pray*.
- 5. For everyone in the Missionaries Cenacle Family: so that each of us who are part of them may be disciples and missionaries of Jesus Christ, being good, doing good and being a power for good. *Let us Pray*
- 6. For the Missionary Servants of the Most Holy Trinity: That motivated by the gifts of the Holy Spirit of strength and wisdom to follow "Preserving the faith, making every Catholic an Apostle" for the next 100 years. *Let us Pray*.
